LADY CHILTERN.....Young and elegant evening gown
LADY BASILDON.....Elegant evening gown
MRS. MARCHMONT.....Elegant evening gown
VICOMTE DE NANJAC.....Tails
MASON.....Butler's full dress livery
LORD CAVERSHAM.....Tails, Order sash with star of Garter.
LADY MARKBY.....Grand Character woman's gown. Not yellow.
MRS. CHEVELEY.....Elegant and sexy heliotrope gown.
SIR ROBERT CHILTERN.....Tails
LORD GORING.....Tails
MR. MONTFORD.....Tails
MISS MABEL CHILTERN.....Evening gown
DUCHESS OF MARYBOROUGH.....Evening gown
FOOTMAN.....Full Dress livery

Act II. Morning room in Sir Robert Chiltern's House. Next day.

LORD GORING.....Extremely fashionable cutaway and gloves.
SIR ROBERT CHILTERN.....Cutaway suit
MASON.....Butler's livery
LADY MARKBY.....Afternoon dress
MRS. CHEVELEY.....Afternoon dress
FOOTMAN.....Daytime livery

Act III. Morning room of Lord Goring's House. That evening.

PHIPPS.....Full dress butler's livery. Valet
LORD GORING.....Repeat Act I. Add silk hat, cape and gloves.
LORD CAVERSHAM.....Repeat Act I. Add silk hat, cape and gloves.
FOOTMAN.....Full dress livery
MRS. CHEVELEY.....Elaborate evening gown and cloak
SIR ROBERT CHILTERN.....Repeat Act I.

Act IV. Same as Act II. Next day.

FOOTMAN.....Livery
LORD GORING.....Daytime suit
LORD CAVERSHAM.....Frock suit and hat
MABEL CHILTERN.....Daytime dress
LADY CHILTERN.....Morning dress
SIR ROBERT CHILTERN.....Morning outfit
MASON.....No change
