

THE BARTERED BRIDE

MARIE: Red peasant skirt with 3 bands of blue 1 inch wide, white organdy blouse, black bodice, white organdy apron, Czech cap (holubicka), red hose, petticoats

JENIK: Tan tight trousers, black boottops or boots, vest and coat, white peasant shirt, red bow tie, pillbox type hat trimmed with fur, red sox

KEZAL: Tight trousers, vest, shirt, knee-length coat, rosette of flowers and ribbons on shoulder, similar rosette on black top hat, red kerchief, large red umbrella, red sox

VASHEK: Similar to JENIK, except for hat and rosette which is similar to KEZAL

LUDMILLA: Dark brocade peasant skirt, apron, long sleeved jacket, holubicka, black shawl, red hose, petticoats

KRUSHINA: Similar to KEZAL

HATA: Similar to LUDMILLA, except brighter colors

MICHA: Similar to KEZAL

PRINCIPAL: Strolling player Pierrot clown costume blouse, trousers, hat, gloves

ESMERALDA: Pierrette tights, tight fitted bodice, skirt

INDIAN: Shirt, pants, wig, headband

CHORUS GIRLS: Red bodices trimmed with gold sequins, various colored skirts, white aprons, red hose, holubicka

CHORUS MEN: Tan trousers, boottops or boots, red or black vest, peasant shirt, hat, red tie. (Shirts are full butterfly sleeved, not cuffed.)

DANCERS: 1. Peasant dress

2. Traveling players - acrobats, clowns, pierrots, harlequins, ballet dancers
