Costume Plot

CANDIDA Dress or suit suitable for October travel for attractive wife of an English Minister. (Tan wool dress with taffeta or braid trim--full gored skirt) (Copenhagen blue might also be an acceptable color for her dress.) Attractive hat of 1894. Short cape. False hair piece braid (Blonde)

REVEREND JAMES MORRELL Black suit of a clergyman of the Church of England(1894)

LEXY MILLS Black suit of a clergyman of the Church of England(1894) also with traditional collar of that church.

BURGESS Brown suit - high collar, cravat, checked vest (or a variation, but slightly showy or of poor taste), derby hat.

EUGENE MARCHBANKS English tweed suit (grey or black and white) possibly a Norfolk jacket. Some unconventional shirt, cravat, collar of that period(1894) (suggestion: woolen lawn tennis shirt, silk hankerchief for a cravat)

PROSPERINE GARNETT High necked, long sleeved blouse or shirt waist in cotton or silk - plain, striped or plaid. Gored wool skirt, very full bottom (wine or green). Color of blouse should be same or at least blend.
