Costume Plot

Time: Early 1900's, afternoon and evening

The action takes place in the drawing room of Chandebise's house in Paris, and in the Hotel Coq D'Or in Montretrout

CAMILLE CHANDEBISE (young gentleman, early 20's)	Afternoon suit of the period, w/accessories
ANTIONETTE PLUCHEUX (The cook, wife of the butler. young attractive)	Maid's dress of the period, apron, cap. Attractive street suit with underblouse (front opening) and hat.
ETIENNE PLUCHEUX (head butler)	Cutaway butler's coat, striped vest w/black sleeves, large striped arpon, wing collar, neckband shrit, four-in-hand tie, Hat, street suit w/accessories.
DR. FIANCHE (middle-aged, good looking)	Cutaway suit, (coat, vest, trousers), shirt, wing collar, ascot, tie, hat, stick, spats.
LUCIENNE HOMENIDES DE HISTANGUA (early 30's, attractive)	Period afternoon dress and accessories, very attractive.
RAYMONDE CHANDEBISE (middle 30's)	Afternoon street dress w/accessories - attractive
VICTOR-EMMANUEL CHANDEBISE	Period cutaway suit with contrasting vest, wing collar, shirt, ascot tie, spats, hat, gloves
ROMAIN TOURNEL (one of his agents, very handsome)	Period sack suit with accessories, hat and gloves
CARLOS HOMENIDES DE HISTANGUA (spanish gentleman)	Period cutaway or frock suit with contrasting vest, wing collar, shirt, period bow tie, hat, cane, spats, gloves
AUGUSTIN FERAILLON (hotel manager, about 45)	Single breasted frock or suit suit, contrasting trousers. Wing collar, shirt, tie, spats, etc.
OLYMPE FERAILLON (his wife, an ex-prostitute, 52 years old)	Period afternoon dress, long sleeves, high neck
BAPTISTIN (Feraillon's uncle)	Period character suit, hat
HERR SCHWARZ (a hotel patron)	Dark period suit w/character vest, shirt w/standing or wing collar, four-in-hand tie, heavy watch chain, spats. Old fashioned long night shirt, bathrobe
EUGENIE (maid)	Black maid's dress of period, pinafore apron, cape
POCHE (an old worker)	Work pants, work shirt, vest. Single breasted blue uniform with standing collar (hotel staff)
EXTRAS (guests at hotel)	Various street clothes of the period to represent assorted French characters.
