Citizen's Son.....Street clothes of period
2 pages.....Livery
Several Thieves.....Street clothes
Orange Girl.....Similar to Flower Girl
1st Marquis.....Elegant to point of foolishness
Cuigy.....Gentleman's fine street clothes
2nd marquis.....Similar to 1st Marquis
Lamplighter.....Similar to Porter
Ligniere.....Well dressed but unkempt
Chirstian.....Elegantly dressed
Brissaille.....Gentleman's street clothes
MMe. De Guemene.....Elegant gown
MMe De Bois-Dauphin.....Elegant gown
MMe De Chavigne.....Elegant gown
Ragueneau.....Middle class - "Sunday best"
Le Bret.....Gentlemen
Roxanne.....Fine gown, cape
Raxanne's Duenna.....Expensive but plain gown
Comte De Guiche.....Elegantly dresses
Vicomte De Valvert.....Elegantly dressed
The Cardinal.....Cardinal's street garb
Montfleury.....Shepherd's costume
Cyrano.....Cavalier's garb
Bellerose.....Conservative material but cut with great flair
Jodelet.....Comic shepherd's costume
Soubrette.....Columbine costume
2 Comedians.....1 young clown - 1 sad old clown

5 Pastry Cooks.....Breeches, blouses, aprons, chrif's hats
Rageneau.....Breeches, blouse vest, apron chef's hat
Apprentice.....Breeches, blouse, apron
Lise (Ragueneau's Wife).....Middle calss street wear
2 Children.....Street clothes
Cyrano.....No change, add cape
1st Muskateer.....No change
5 poets.....Shabby dark clothes

Roxanne.....No change, cape hood mask
 Roxanne's Duenna.....No change, add cape
 Carbon De Castel.....Jaloux.. Capt. of the Guards
 Cadets.....Cavalier clothes
 Le Bret.....No change
 Citizens.....No change
 Marais, De Guiche,
 Cruigy, Officers, Christian..No change

ACT II. Small village square in the old Marais; Early evening; Several days later

Ragueneau.....Livery of Roxanne's household
 Roxanne's Duenna.....No change, add shawl
 Cyrano.....No change
 2 Pages.....No change
 Roxanne.....Change gown, cape w/hood
 Deguiche.....Change
 Christian.....No change
 A Capuchin.....Monk's garb

ACT IV Post at Arras - Several weeks later

Le Bret.....Plain cavalier's garb, worn and dusty
 Carbon....."
 Cadets and sentries.....No change; Un-kempt
 Cyrano.....Similar to Le Bret
 M. De Guiche.....Similar to Le Bret
 Roxanne.....Gown, cape w/hood
 Ragueneau.....Coachman's livery

ACT V. The park of the Convent - 1655

Nuns.....Habits
 Mother Superior.....Habit
 Roxanne.....Widow's weeds
 Deguiche.....Similar to ACT I, but older, more conservative
 Le Bret.....Similar to De Guiche
 Ragueneau.....Middle class street clothes
 Cyrano.....Dark shabby clothes simialr to poet's in ACT II,
 cape, large brim cavalier's hat w/plume
