Costume Plot

ACT I. The kitchen and general dwelling room of Mrs. Dudgeon's home in New Hampshire. A winter night in 1777.

Mrs. Dudgeon.....Dark, old work dress, shawl. Change to plain black dress
Essie.....A scanty, dirty ill fitting dress
Christy.....Overcoat, plaid shawl, hat, plain worn pants and coat
Anthony Adneron.....Clerical costume of the period, cloak, hat
Judith Anderson.....Pretty ingenue type dress, cloak, bonnet
Lawyer Hawkins.....Riding gaiters, breeches, coat, hat, cloak
William Dudgeon.....Plain, poor looking costumes, coat, hat
Titus Dudgeon.....Fancy coat, breeches, coat and hat
Mrs. William Dudgeon.....Plain poor looking dress, cloak, bonnet
Mrs. Titus Dudgeon.....Fancy dress, cloak, bonnet
Dick Dudgeon.....Dashing, careless looking coat, breeches, cloak, hat

Act II. Minister Anderson's house. Evening.

Judith.....Pretty house dress, purse
Anderson.....No change. Add old coat, for unstage change, riding boots, belt and holster
Dick Dudgeon.....Coat, waistcoat, breeches, boots, shirt
Christy.....No change
English Sergeant.....British uniform
2 English privates.....British uniforms
Essie.....Simple dress and cloak

Act III, Scene 1. British headquarters at town hall. Next morning.

JudithAdd cloak and bonnet
All others.....No change

Act III, Scene 2. Council Chambers.

Major Swindon.....British uniform
General Burgoyne.....British uniform, general's insignia
A NUMBER OF BRITISH, GERMAN AND HESSIAN OFFICERS, MEMBERS OF THE COURT MARTIAL
All Others.....No change

Act III, Scene 3. The market place.

Townspeople.....Assorted costumes of the period
Soldiers.....Some British infantry, some Hessian uniforms
Chaplain.....Surplice and robe
Executioner.....Soldier pants and shirt
Band.....British uniforms
All others.....No change
