Act I Library of Dr. Seward's sanatorium, Purly, England, evening.

Act II Lucy's boudoir, evening of next day.

Act III, sc. I thirty-two hours later, same as Act I
sc. II A vault just after sunrise.

ACT I:

MAID: An attractive young girl, blsck maids uniform, apron, cap,
can be dated.

JONATHAN HARKER: About 27, typical Englishman, 3 pc. period tweed
suit, not loud or comic, a conservative Norfolk with knickers
and hat, would also do.

DR. SEWARD: A specialist, about 55, period tuxedo.

PROF. ABRAHAM VAN HEISING: In his 50's, dark oxford 3 pc period suit
can be any other dark color, no pattern or stripe, just plain suit.

RENFIELD: A patient, can wear an odd coat, pants, grey cardigan
sweater, open shirt.

ATTENDANT: Blue grey uniform & cap, hospital attendant, a guard
uniform, should have large outside pockets to put the mouse
box in.

LUCY: DR. Seward's daughter, sick girl, beautiful, about 20. A long
filmy white negligee, semi-revealing, white chiffon scarf
about 1½ yds long.

COUNT DRACULA: A full dress suit, small ribbon and decorations
at neck aroung wing collar, a long almost floor length black
inverness cape, lined in deep purple.

ACT II:

HARKER: A period 3 pc business suit, dark blue or brown.

DR. SEWARD: A conservative period sack suit.

ACT III:

All repeat

RE: Count Dracula cape can be long full black cape with high
collar .
