GLASS MENAGERIE

(The action takes place in the drab tenement apartment of the Wingfield Family. The locale is the poor section of St. Louis, the winter, about 1935.)

ACT I SCENE 1:

Tom: the brother: About 22. Merchant sailor's outfit. dark trousers, blue or gray work shirt, Navy pea jacket, dark knitted skull cap, wool muffler, dress coat and civilian overcoat.

AMANDA (the mother): About 50. Dark housedress of the period should be well worn and rather funny.

LAURA (the daughter): About 24. Housedress of the period. Not new and in a pastel color to emphasize for fragility.

ACT I SCENE 2:

AMANDA: Worn winter coat with imitation fur collar, cut-of-date, cloche hat, worn leather purse.

ACT I SCENE 4:

LAURA: Winter coat or cape

ACT III SCENE 7 EARLY SPRING:

LAURA: Pastel evening gown, soft & flowing. Not too fresh, looks like it had been purchased in a bargain basement.

AMANDA: GIRLISH evening gown of 1910 to 1915 period. Has once been pretty but has been packed in a trunk for 20 years.

JIM (Gentleman Caller): About 25. Suit of the period, vest, shirt tie
