- I-1 Grey striped trousers, black vest, short morning coat (stroller), standing sing collar, ascot
 - I-2 Repeat with bowler
 - I-8 Striped blazer, white slacks, checked Dutch cap, white high shoes (quick change)
 - I-9 Different blazer, straw hat
 - I-10 Change blazer
 - II-1 Blazer & grey striped pants
 - II-3 Morning coat & top hat
 - II-4 Add smoking jacket
 - II-5 Short cutaway jacket with velvet collar & square top derby (pants I-1)
 - II-8 Repeat I-1 with smoking jacket
- } all with pants I-8
- } all with pants I-1

SID Plaid suit, odd vest, derby

BUGGINS Blazer, summer pants, straw pants

PEARCE Blazer with velvet collar, odd pants & vest, bowler

APPRENTICES

- I-1 3-button, 3 pe. suits, standing wing collars, 4-in-hand ties, bowler hats
- I-10 Short grey morning suits & hats
- II-7 Carolers. Assorted wraps, caps, scarves, mitts

CARSHOT Head floorwalker. Long black morning coat, grey striped trousers, vest, black square top bowler

MR. SHALFORD Grey frock coated suit, black top hat

SINGING MEN

- I-1 Assorted customers - suit, hat, etc.
- I-4 Assorted rough clothes, including bartender & pub customers
- I-9 Peried suits, straw hats, colored vests & shirts
- II-6 Assorted workmen's clothes, hats, kerchiefs
- II-7 Carolers. Assorted wraps, caps, scarves, mitts

DANCING BOYS

- I-1 Assorted salesmen and stockboys
- I-4 Assorted shirts, vest, sleeve garters, rough pants, - customers (Also English sailor types)
- I-9 Peried blazers, slacks, straw hats
- II-1 Assorted piped blazers, vests, white pants
- II-6 Assorted workmen's ~~clothes~~ clothes, hats, kerchiefs

FLO, VICTORIA, KATE, EMMA

- I-1 Black calf length dresses, high white collars, short reversible capes, straw hats, colored petticoats
- I-9 Assorted shirtwaists and skirts, hats & parasols
- II-3 Bridesmaids
- II-7 Carolers. Assorted coats, capes, bonnets, gloves

MRS. WALSINGHAM

- I-1 Grande dame. Elegantly dresses shopper. Hat, bag, gloves, etc.
- I-10 Elaborate garden dress. (May use same without coat)
- II-1 Formal tea gown & hat

MRS. BOTTING

- I-1 Her sidekick. Also elegantly dressed.
- I-10 Elaborate garden dress - use I-1 without coat
- II-1 Formal tea gown and hat

ANN

- I-2 Pretty cockney girl. Ankle length dress, hat, bag. Blue and white sailor dress, white beater hat
- I-10 Black & white maid's costume, apron, cap, and bloomers w/pocket
- II-3 Wedding gown, veil, bouquet
- II-4 Peignoir (over wedding gown) - quick change
- II-6 Street outfit
- II-8 Nice shirtwaist & skirt

SINGING GIRLS

- I-1 Assorted customers (may use without coats for I-6)
- I-6 Shirtwaists & skirts, high collars (students)
- I-9 Assorted shirtwaists, skirts, hats & parasols - different blouses
- I-10 Art nouveau garden dresses & hats
- II-6 Period suits, blouses & hats (I-1)
- II-7 Carolers. Assorted coats, capes, bonnets, gloves

DANCING GIRLS

- I-1 Assorted shorter dress customer. Plus 1 shoplifter, 1 DG with ribbon
- I-9 Assorted shirtwaists, skirts, hats & parasols - different blouse
- II-1 Assorted gowns
- II-6 Period suits, blouses, & hats

LAURA Dance ball type dress, lace stockings, garter, etc.

HELEN WALSINGHAM

- I-3 Elegant young lady's dress, hat, jacket, blouse & skirt
- I-6 Repeat I-3 without jacket, blouse & skirt
- I-8 Walking dress & hat
- II-1 Pretty light pastel gown
- II-6 1/2 Maid's uniform
