- III Sack suit, vest

CATHERINE

- I Dinner dress
- II Tea gown
- III Light morning gown

JOHN

- I Tuxed suit, overcoat, felt hat
- II Repeat I
- III Sweater, repeat trousers
- EPI Conservative dark suit

ELEANOR

- I Wool suit, hat
- II Tea gown or dressmaker suit, hat, bag
- III Morning gown, unsuitable for ice skating

ANGELLA NEWCOMBE

- I Dinner gown
- II Suit, jacket, skirt and blouse, In this act wear only skirt and blouse
- III Add jacket, hat, umbrella

ROGER NEWCOMBE

- I Cutaway suit
- II Sack suit, hat, coat
- III Repeat II
- EPI Black coat, gray vest, striped trousers of Act I

HORATIO WILLING

- I Cutaway suit
- II Sack suit
- III Repeat II

JANE WILLING

- I Subdued dinner dress - galoshes
- II Tea gown - plain

AGNES WILLING

- I Dinner dress with hairbow
- II Dowdy white ball gown, long white gloves, piece of tulle they fit into neckline which is not really slow at all.

**HOWARD BOULDER**

- I Tweed suit, vest, overcoat, felt hat
- II Repeat I
- III Knicker suit, or herringbone or subdued plaid

**LIDIA LETTON**

- II Teagown

**EMILY SOUTHWORTH**

- II Tea gown

**JULIAN DALE**

- III Sack suit, mature and conservative - not black. Nicely dressed successful business executive. Hat and coat

**HENRY AND WILSON**

- Butler livery. Could double with same coat and trousers, changing vest if size is right.

**MARGARET**

- Meticulously starched maid's costume
