3 Act Play by Sara Spencer
dramatized from Louisa May Alcott's story

Time: 1863

Act I, Sc. 1 (2 days before Christmas)

Jo: Afternoon dress, casual and comfortable (Tom Boy type)
Meg: Attractive afternoon dress
Beth: Attractive afternoon dress
Amy: Plain afternoon dress (younger look)
Marmee (Mrs. March): Outdoor wrap and bonnet
afternoon dress under
Laurie: Boy next door: Coat and hat
suit of the period

Act I, Sc. 2 (Christmas eve. night)

Three girls: skirts and blouses
Hannah: Servant dress and apron
Marmee: repeat Sc. 1 dress
Aunt March: severe dark dress of the period
Laurie: Handsom cut suit
Jo: Russet boots, slashed doublet etc. for "show".
Meg: "Hagar the Witch" costume
Amy: Lovely white "tarlatan" dress, roses in hair
Beth: "Imp" costume w/hood
Jo: Add plumed cap and red cloak

Act II (Several weeks later)

Meg: Skirt and blouse of the period
Amy: " " " " "
Beth: " " " " "
Jo: " " " " "
Jo: Cape and muffler
Laurie: Outer cape-coat, hat, muffler
Hannah: (repeat outfit)
Jo: Colorful knitted cap and coat
Amy: Coat, scarf, knitted hat
Aunt March: Outer coat and hat
repeat day dress
Beth: re-enters in coat, cap and mittens

Act III (Two months later)

Aunt March: Bonnet and shawl
repeat dress or optional change
Jo: Pretty daytime dress
Laurie: can repeat Act I, sc. 1
Mrs. March: optional change to skirt and blouse
Amy: Bonnet and stoll over optional change
Meg: skirt and blouse
Beth: skirt and blouse
Mr. March: Suit and hat of the period
