Ingenu dress, fontage

Cleante (Harpagon's Son, Mariana's lover)
Dashing suit of the period.

Harpagon (Father to Cleante and Elise, in love with
Mariane) Mature suit of the period, hat.

La Fleche (Cleante's valet)
Simple livery, breeches, blouse, vest, cap.
(Pockets in pants and/or vest.)

Simon (Agent) Conservative suit
