

The Mouse That Roared

<u>Character</u>	<u>Description</u>
Tully	(1) Forest Ranger - Robin Hood Type, Dark Green in color, Peaker & Raked Hat (with feather) (2) Military costume - middle ages, gothic period - (Chain mail, below waist, sleeves, over blouse, tights, helmet (decorated so that he is distinguished as leader), long bow & quiver with arrows, sword (costume should be colorful) (3) Elaborate Military Costume - profuse with gold braid - epiletts - Admiral's Napoleon style hat, etc. (overdone)
General Snippet	(1) Modern General of the U.S. Army, as authentic as can be achieved. (<u>This is a must</u>)- Tie and Hat
Will Tatum	(1) Soldier's costume - middle ages, gothic period. Same as Tully's, except colors which are more drab. Helmet, belt.
Soldiers (4)	To be costumed alike, middle ages, gothic period * Tunic, chain mail, hood. Men of Grand Fenwick. Shields.
Gloriana	Duchess costume. White brocade dress, tiarra or crown.
Norma	Lady in Waiting. Similar to but not as elaborate as Gloriana. Lace dress, hat.
Helen	Court dress, hat. Same as Norma.
Page	Page Boy's costume (speaks for itself)
Ann	Peasant type costume. Peasant skirt, blouse, apron bodice, and lace cap.
Jill Debbie	{ Women in the WAC Corp of the U.S. Army, modern costume. skirts, shirts, 2 caps, 2 ties.
Mrs. Bascom	Tully's Mother - Middle ages styled costume of an elderly lady. Dress and hat.
Count Mount Joy	Front, collar, tie, hat.
David Benter	Front, collar, tie, hat.

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Special Notes:

1. The helmets for Tully, Tatum and the soldiers are very important to the play. Should be as believable as possible.
2. Grey knit material with metallic thread interwoven can simulate chain mail.
3. Soldiers, Tatum, and Tully should have shields also.
