MEG, Maid Servant	Complete serving maid's dress Long cloak and bonnet Complete maid's dress for Sunday wear. Wig
COMFORT KIRKLAND (Aaron Kirkland's Wife)	Wool colonial dress Dress for Sunday best. Bonnet Colonial dressing sacque White or grey wig
PRUDENCE KIRKLAND (Daughter)	Simple colonial dress. Long cloak and bonnet Dress for Sunday best. Bonnet, shoulder shawl Wig
MOSE (Colored Servant)	Complete house servant's costume of period Long old-fashioned nightgown and cap Negro wig
SONS OF LIBERTY	1 each. Complete costumes for Sons of Liberty Connecticut Militia of 1777, Blue and Buff. Colored or white wigs
REV. LYMAN BANKS	Complete black clerical costume of period Grey bag wig
THADDEUS JENNINGS (Sheriff)	Complete costume for local Commander of Sons of Liberty Dark red bag wig
COL. MORTIMER SHERWOOD	Complete Colonel's uniform for Virginia Light Horse Cavalry. Sword and sword belt White wig Great coat
CAPT. AARON KIRKLAND (N. E. Farmer)	Complete Captain's uniform for Connecticut Militia Sword and belt Long old-fashioned nightgown and cap White or grey bag wig
MAX CHRISTIAN (lead)	Complete Officer's uniform of the Hessian Army Sword and belt, gauntlets, Military cloak, Hessian helmet Natural color bag wig Complete civilian costume White wig if desired
