I-1 -- May, 1873, early morning

Rev. Mr. Edgar Spevin -- Cleric's black suit, overcoat, hat
Sarah -- Tasteless middleclass travelling dress, wrap, hat, bag
Gwendolyn (Age 14) -- Drab child's travelling dress, wrap, hat, bag
Bar Maid -- Black dress
Two Waiters -- Black pants, vest, ties, white shirts and aprons
Courier -- Uniform
Hubert, Marquess of Heronden -- Very good smart travelling suit, hat,
coat, gloves, stick
Charlotte (Mrs. Axel Diensen) -- Beautifully and expensively dressed --
dress, wrap, hat, gloves, bag
Several Travellers -- Men and women of the period

I-2 -- Same day, afternoon

Catchpole -- Complete butler's livery of the period
Serena -- Very rich and tasteful afternoon dress
Lady Harriet Ripley -- Afternoon dress, hat, bag
Footman -- Livery
Axel Diensen -- Well-tailored expensive frock suit

II-1 -- Morning, three days later

Hubert -- Elaborate brocade dressing gown and cap, trousers, shirt, tie
Charlotte -- Elaborate frilled negligee and cap
Serena -- Dress, hat, wrap
Axel -- Change 1, another similar suit for travelling
Mr. Spevin -- No change, except drop coat

II-2 -- Following morning

Axel -- No change
Serena -- Morning dress
Charlotte -- Morning dress
Hubert -- Suit (partly underdressed in II-1)
Octavia, Countess of Bonnington -- Very good by shabby tea gown, three
ropes of good pearls, several expensive bracelets, lorgnette on
black ribbon round neck, hat, gloves

II-3 -- Same evening

Serena, Charlotte, Hubert, Axel -- All in travelling clothes

III-1 -- June, 1874, afternoon

Serena -- Afternoon dress
Hubert -- Change 2, another suit
Catchpole -- No change
Lady Harriet Ripley -- Afternoon dress, hat, gloves, bag (Change 1)
Footman -- No change

III-2 -- Early the following morning

Travellers -- Some change from I-1
Mr. Spevin -- Repeat I-1
Sarah -- Change 1
Gwendolyn -- Change 1
Courier -- Repeat I-1
Axel -- Change 2
Serena -- Elaborate travelling dress, hat, bag, gloves, wrap
Waiter -- Repeat I-1
