ACT I Scene 2 Chinon - March 8, 1429

TREMOUILLE (Lord Chamberlain).....Robe
ARCHBISHOP.....Ecclesiastical garb
PAGE.....Livery
GILLES de RAIS (Bluebeard).....Stylish tunic
CAPTAIN LA HIRE.....Military tunic, breastplate, helmet
DAUPHIN (later Charles VIII).....Royal tunic
DUCHESS de la TREMOUILLE.....Gown, headpiece
LADIES IN WAITING.....Assorted gowns, headpieces
COURTIERS.....Assorted tunics, robes, headpieces
MEN AT ARMS.....Chain mail tunics
JOAN.....Simple soldier's tunic, tights

ACT I Scene 3 Orleans - April 29, 1429

DUNOIS.....Tunic, armour, helmet
PAGE.....Livery
JOAN.....Chain mail, armour

ACT I Scene 4 English Camp

EARL OF WARWICK.....Nobleman's tunic, cape, hat
CHAPLAIN de STEGUMBER.....Cardinal's costume
PAGE.....Livery
CAUCHON (Bishop of Beauvais).....Ecclesiastical costume

ACT I Scene 5 Cathedral of Rheims

JOAN.....Handsome tunic
DUNOIS.....No change
KING CHARLES.....Coronation tunic or robe
GILLES de RAIS.....Optional change
LA HIRE.....No change
ARCHBISHOP.....No change

ACT I Scene 6 The castle at Rouen

PAGE.....No change
EARL OF WARWICK.....Optional change
CAUCHON.....No change
MONKS.....Robes with cowls
INQUISITOR.....Black robe
D'ESTIVET (Canon).....Robe
de STOGUMBER.....No change
de COURCELLES.....Priest's garb
ASSESSORS.....Assorted monk's robes, cowls
JOAN.....Plain black tunic
EXECUTIONER.....Black tunic, hood

ACT I Scene 7 Charles' Bedroom 1456

CHARLES.....Night gown
SOLDIER.....Chain mail tunic
GENTLEMAN of 1920.....Black frock suit, hat
ALL OTHERS.....Repeat
