

**Costume Plot: A Soldier's Play**

**Capt. Taylor:**

1. Khaki blouse (coat), pants, shirt (with epaulets), tie, service cap. Double silver bar on both epaulets of shirt and on both epaulets of blouse. U.S. insignia (no backing) on both sides of blouse collar and on right side of shirt collar, infantry insignia (crossed rifles-no backing) on blouse lapels and on left side of shirt collar, division patch left sleeve of both shirt and blouse. Officer's cap insignia (large eagle-no backing) on hat, and officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt. Three rows of ribbons above right breast pocket of both shirt and blouse (should be identical ribbons\*).

2. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in), pants, belt, field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Double silver bar on both sides of collar and on front of cap. Officer's brass buckle (with eagle) on belt, division patch left sleeve.

**Capt. Davenport:**

1. Khaki blouse (coat), pants, shirt (with epaulets), tie, service cap. Double silver bar on both epaulets of shirt, and on both epaulets of blouse. U.S. insignia (no backing) on both sides of blouse collar and on right side of shirt collar, military police insignia (crossed pistols-no backing) on blouse lapels and on left side of shirt collar, Military District of Washington patch (Washington Monument with sword though it) left sleeve of both shirt and blouse. Officer's cap insignia (large eagle-no backing) on hat, and officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt. One row of ribbons above right breast pocket of both shirt and blouse (should be identical ribbons\*).

**Capt. Wilcox:**

1. Khaki blouse (coat), pants, shirt (with epaulets), tie, service cap. Double silver bar on both sides of shirt collar and on both epaulets of blouse. U.S. insignia (no backing) on both sides of blouse collar and on right side of shirt collar, medical insignia (caduceus-no backing) on blouse lapels and on left side of shirt collar, division patch left sleeve of both shirt and blouse. Officer's cap insignia (large eagle-no backing) on hat, and officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt. Two rows of ribbons above right breast pocket of both shirt and blouse (should be identical ribbons\*).

2. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in), pants, belt, helmet or field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Double silver bar on both sides of collar and on front helmet or cap. Officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt, division patch left sleeve. Backpack, ammo belt with gun and holster, canteen.

\* Actor may switch ribbons from blouse to shirt.

**Lt. Byrd:**

1. Khaki blouse (coat), pants, shirt (with epaulets), tie, service cap. Single silver bar on both sides of shirt collar and on both epaulets of blouse. Officer's U.S. insignia (no backing) on both sides of blouse collar and on right side of shirt collar, ordinance insignia (exploding bomb-no backing) on blouse lapels and on left side of shirt collar, division patch left sleeve of both shirt and blouse. Officer's cap insignia (large eagle-no backing) on hat, and officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt. One row of ribbons above right breast pocket of both shirt and blouse (should be identical ribbons\*).

2. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in), pants, belt, helmet or field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Single silver bar on both sides of collar and on front helmet or cap. Officer's brass buckle (eagle) on belt, division patch left sleeve. Backpack, ammo belt with gun and holster, canteen.

**Sgt. Waters:**

1. Khaki blouse (coat), pants, shirt (no epaulets), tie, service cap (may also have overseas hat and/or campaign hat). Tech sergeant's chevrons on both sleeves of both blouse and shirt. Enlisted man's U.S. insignia (on circle) on right lapel of blouse and enlisted man's infantry insignia (crossed rifles on circle) on left lapel of blouse. Same U.S. insignia on right side of shirt collar and same infantry insignia on left side of shirt collar. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons on both shirt and blouse. Enlisted man's cap insignia (small eagle on circle) on service cap or campaign hat, nothing on the overseas cap. Plain brass buckle on belt. Three rows of ribbons above right breast pocket of both shirt and blouse (should be identical ribbons\*). Five service stripes on lower left sleeve of blouse.

**Pfc. Peterson:**

1. Khaki shirt (no epaulets), pants, belt, tie, and overseas hat. Private First Class chevrons (single stripe) on both sleeves, division patch on left sleeve above chevrons. Enlisted man's U.S. insignia (on circle) on right side of shirt collar and enlisted man's infantry insignia (crossed rifles on circle) on left side of shirt collar. Plain brass belt buckle.

2. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Private First Class chevrons (single stripe) on both sleeves, division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

3. Full baseball uniform with jersey, shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

4. G.I. undershirt and boxer shorts, dog tags.

5. Field (baseball style) jacket, helmet, utility belt with holster and pistol.

\* Actor may switch ribbons from blouse to coat

**Cpl. Cobbs:**

1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Corporal chevrons (double stripe) on both sleeves, division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

2. Full baseball uniform with jersey (shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

3. G.I. undershirt and boxer shorts, dog tags.

**Pvt. Memphis:**

1. 1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

2. Full baseball uniform with jersey (shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

3. G.I. undershirt and sweat pants, dog tags.

**Pvt. Wilkie:**

1. 1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

2. Full baseball uniform with jersey (shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

**Pvt. Henson:**

1. 1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

2. Full baseball uniform with jersey (shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

**Pvt. Smalls:**

1. 1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

2. Full baseball uniform with jersey (shirt, pants, belt, cap, and socks. Uniform has "Ft. Neal" patch on shirt and cap.

**Pvt. Ellis:**

1. Olive drab fatigue shirt (worn tucked in) (worn tucked in), pants, belt (plain brass buckle), field (baseball style) cap, leggings (khaki spats) or combat boots. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons.

or

1. Khaki shirt, pants, belt, tie, overseas hat. Division patch on left sleeve above chevrons. Enlisted man's U.S. insignia (on circle) on right side of shirt collar and enlisted man's infantry insignia (crossed rifles on circle) on left side of shirt collar. Plain brass belt buckle.
