Action takes place in the drawing room of the Winslow house in Kensington - extended over a two-year period prior to World War I.

I-1 Sunday morning in July.

RONNIE.....Osborne naval cadet uniform
VIOLET.....Maid's uniform, apron
MR. WINSLOW (ARTHUR).....Period suit
MRS. WINSLOW (GRACE).....Dressy frock, hat, gloves, parasol
DICKIE.....Period suit
CATHERINE.....Simple suit dress, accessories
JOHN WATHERSTONE.....Morning suit
DESMOND CURRY.....Period suit
RONNIE.....Change to dressing gown

I-2 Evening, the following April.

DICKIE.....Slacks, shirt, lounge jacket
CATHERINE.....Evening dress, cloak, gloves, scarf
VIOLET.....No change
ARTHUR.....Dressing gown
MISS BARNES.....Untidy dress, rather too fussy
GRACE.....Street dress
FRED.....Rather ill-kempt period suit
DESMOND.....Change, similar to I-1
SIR ROBERT.....Foppishly dapper, but not burlesqued
RONNIE.....Eton suit
JOHN.....Evening clothes

II-1 Late evening, the following January.

ARTHUR.....No change
RONNIE.....Knicker suit
GRACE.....House dress
VIOLET.....Change, another uniform
CATHERINE.....Conservative dress, hat
SIR ROBERT.....Dark suit, similar to I-2
JOHN.....Period suit

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II-2 July afternoon, same year.

DICKIE.....Dark blue suit, straw hat
GRACE.....Summer dress, slightly frivolous
ARTHUR.....Slacks, shirt, light lounge jacket
CATHERINE.....Simple, but attractive summer frock
DESMOND.....Light summer suit
VIOLET.....Street dress, hat
SIR ROBERT.....Back to I-2
RONNIE.....No change, drop jacket from I-1
