Penelope Sycamore: (Early 50's type) House dress of the period
Act II Artist smock over another dress

Essie: (daughter) skirt, blouse of the period, ballet slippers
Act II: Ballet Costume, tutu, tights, slippers.

Rheba: (30's, the Maid) stock uniform and apron

Paul Sycamore: (Mid 50's) shirt, vest, trousers

Dr. DePenna: similar to above
Act II: Roman toga, headband, sandals

Ed: Overcoat on entrance, remove to plain suit

Donald: (Rheba's "beau") Jacket, shirt, trousers

Martin Vanderhof: (around 75) trousers, shirt, cardigan sweater

Alice: (around 22) Pretty day dress of the period
Another change

Henderson: (government man) business suit and hat

Tony Kirby: Blazer coat, trousers, shirt, tie
Act II, Full dress tuxedo

Boris Kalenkhov: (Russian Ballet instructor) Black trousers,
striped shirt w/ arm bands, black vest, coat, hat.

Gay Willington: (tipsie, showgirl type) loud flowing dress of the period.

Mr. Kirby: Full dress tuxedo

Mrs. Kirby: Evening gown of the period

Three Men: Business suits (G-men type)

Olga: (Grand Duchess Olga Katrina) Dinner gown which has
"seen better days", tacky evening wrap
